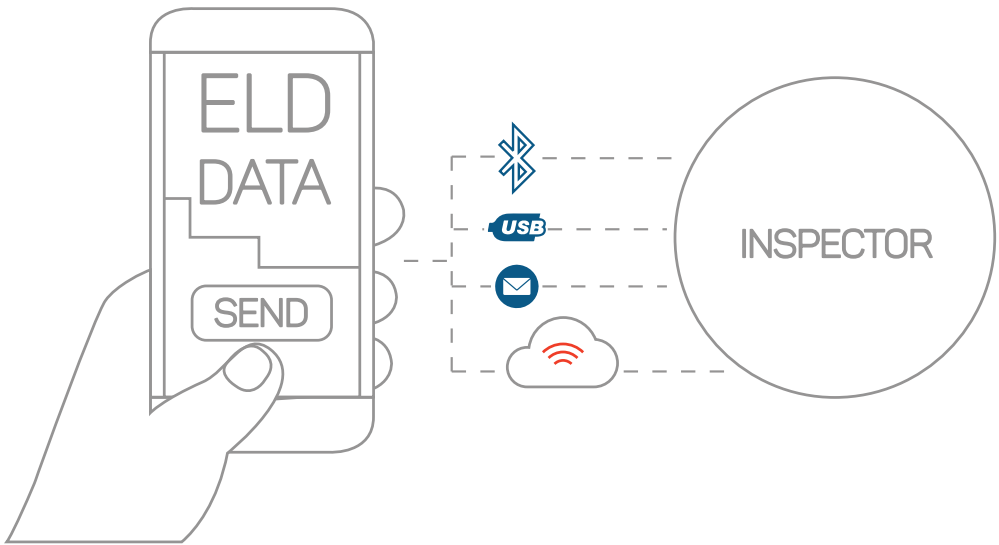


Titan GPS ELD

The Titan GPS ELD plugs into the diagnostic port in a vehicle and is integrally synchronized with the engine. The ELD automatically records driving time and connects to the Titan GPS app on the driver's mobile device via Bluetooth/ USB/ Email or Web Service. Drivers are not able to edit driving time when using the Titan GPS ELD.



The Titan GPS ELD is compliant with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulation 49 CFR & 395.15 regarding automatic on-board recording devices.



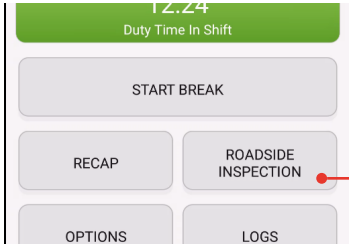
The Titan GPS ELD is compliant with Section 83 of the Commercial Vehicle Drivers Hours of Service Regulations regarding the use of electronic recording devices

(Weekdays between 8 Am to 5 Pm MST)



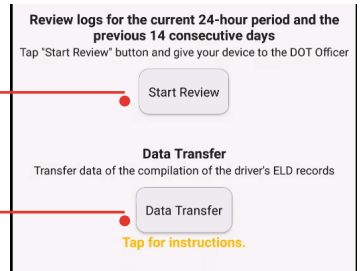
On the app Home Screen, tap the 'ROADSIDE INSPECTION' button to enter inspection mode.

Note: The app will ask to verify your password to return back to home screen.

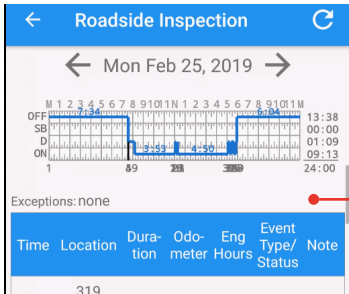
Tap Start Review button to display logs on the device and continue to Step 3.

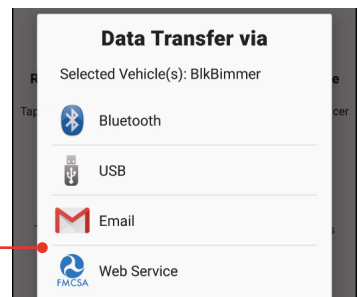
